

Guidelines for Selected Chromebooks Usage Offenses

<u>Infraction</u>	<u>Consequences</u>
<p>Leaving the Chromebook unsupervised/unattended.</p> <p><u>Examples:</u> Outside the locker or backpack, on the floor or inside and outside classrooms.</p>	<p>First time: Up to 48 hours confiscation. Second time: One week (5 School Days) Third time: Consequences will be determined by the administration as one or more of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Long term confiscation (period TBD.) ● Revoke of privilege to use the Chromebook. ● Three Demerits on Renweb.
<p>Transportation: Carrying the Chromebook without its protective case or with one hand or in any reckless way.</p>	<p>First time: A written warning on Renweb. Second time: Confiscation for one day and a demerit on Renweb. Third time: Confiscation for three days and Two demerits on Renweb.</p>
<p>Failing to return the Chromebook before leaving the school campus or when requested</p>	<p>First time: <u>Confiscation for three days and one demerit.</u> Second time: <u>One week (5 School Days) confiscation and two demerits on Renweb.</u> Third time: <u>Consequences will be determined by the administration as one or more of the following:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● <u>Long term confiscation (period TBD.)</u> ● <u>Revoke of privilege to use the Chromebook.</u> ● <u>Three Demerits on Renweb.</u>
<p>Technology misuse reported by teachers to the administration, including being off-task.</p>	<p>First time: Up to 48 hours confiscation. Second time: One week (5 School Days). Third time: <u>possible termination of the right.</u></p>

At administration's discretion and on a case-by-case basis, different, additional and more serious consequences may be enforced depending on frequency and severity of the offense
